



FARMERS MARKET RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All food items sold at the Farmers Market must be homemade, baked, grown, raised, caught or wild harvested in West Virginia by the person or persons making the application or their designee.
2. Vendors agree The Sutton Farmers Market or the Town of Sutton will not be held liable for any injury, theft or damages of any kind while in attendance of the market.
3. The Sutton Farmers Market and Town of Sutton recommend each vendor carries their own liability insurance including food poisoning for their own protection.
4. Vendors shall NOT have exclusivity on any product or products.
5. All vendors must submit a completed application form.
6. All vendors selling food items must provide a current copy of a lisenche/letter of approval from the Braxton County Health Department.
7. All ingredients must be listed on baked or cooked food products.
8. All vendors must conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner.
9. All vendors are responsible for removing their own trash. Please take to the Towns trash receptacles in parking lot.
10. All vendors are responsible for their own taxation obligations.
11. Markets open at 8:00AM to the public and closes at 12:00PM, or until product is no longer available every Saturday beginning May 16 and ending in Late September early October. (this date to be decided later in the season)
12. All items for sale must be clearly marked.
13. Smoking is not permitted within the confinements of the food marketplace as ordered by the Braxton County Health Department.
14. No pets are permitted around the Farmers Market Food Section unless they are service pet. In other areas pets are required to be in cages or on a leash.
